Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico, Zaccagnini - Marche, Italy <i>Pale straw yellow with a green hue. Delicate and elegant, with notes of yeast and fresh bread. Fresh, dry, savoury with a pleasant finish and excellent acidity.</i>	-	-	£29
Cloud Cuckoo Land, Wild & Wilder - Riverland, South Australia, Australia <i>A vibrant, textural white with hints of almond blossom, quince and ripe pear. Tangy, almost exotic but pithy and delicious.</i>	-	-	£33
Elgin Highlands Sauvignon Blanc, Iona Elgin, South Africa <i>Fragrance of pure white grapefruit, intense tropical fruit, ripe gooseberry and fleshy kiwi fruit over-lay Iona's distinctive herbal and floral undertone. The palate is keenly balanced showing cut green apples and lime marmalade followed by great minerality and length.</i>	£6.5	£8.5	£36
Bourgogne Chardonnay, Les Fortunes, Domaine Chanzy Cote Chalonnaise, Burgundy, France <i>This wine is a synthesis of finesse and freshness that is enhanced by the fruitiness that Chardonnay can bring.</i>	£9	£12	£50
Majuelo del Chiviritero, Isaac Cantalapiedra - Castilla y Leon, Spain <i>Natural and ripe, this is incredibly well made certified organic Verdejo, with just the right amount of oak. Straw coloured, with a medley of tropical Fruit in the nose.</i>	-	-	£58
Sancerre Blanc, Les Perrois, Domaine Francois Crochet - Sancerre, Loire Valley, France <i>Fresh, pure and elegant with blackcurrant leaf and gooseberry on the nose. This is textbook Sancerre which has fruit and minerality in perfect proportions. Fresh citrus fruit acidity supports stony fruit and minerality on the palate.</i>	-	-	£65

ROSÉ WINE

Vinho Verde, Portugal

A light pink colour, the nose contains elegant and fresh summer fruit aromas followed by a delicious mouthful of wild summer berry flavours.

Les Deux Anges, Chateau L'Escarelle - - £40

Cotes de Provence, France

Subtle and elegant with wild strawberry and citrus fruit on the nose. The palate is clean and fresh with beautiful smoothness and mango and pomelo notes.

RED WINE

Electric Bee, Produttori di Manduria £5 £7 £28

Puglia, Italy

Very intense and incredibly complex, this beautifully crafted wine has an aroma reminiscent of ripe cherry, plum, and blackberry, yet retains a delicate freshness and softness on the palate.

Armador Merlot, Odfjell - - £32

Maipo, Chile

Intense garnet red in colour with a violet hue. The nose is ripe but fresh, with fruity notes recalling black cherries and plums along with a bit of menthol, while notes of spices such as nutmeg appear on the backdrop. The palate is juicy, and the tannins are robust and velvety, leading with notes of blackberries and chocolate on the lingering finish.

Le Reveur Cotes du Rhone Rouge, £6.5 £8.5 £36

Guillaume Gonnet

Southern Rhone, France

The wine is fleshy, ripe and finishes with impressive forest floor sweetness, rounded out by peppery tannins. Think crème de cassis, cherries, and a lovely note of liquorice on the palate, mixed with pepper and Asian spices.

Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

A delicate bouquet of red fruits and subtle spice whilst red pepper and soft tannins add to the fruit and fills the palate with hints of liquorice.

Moveable Feast, The Drift Farm £9.5 £12.5 £50

Overberg Highlands, South Africa

The nose shows a beguiling mixture of ripe mulberry, white pepper, framed in a touch of toasty, vanilla oak and just the faintest hint of minty caramel chocolate. The palate echos the blackcurrant, mulberry and dark cherry. The tannins are super smooth, long and persistent.

Syrah, Qupé - - £56

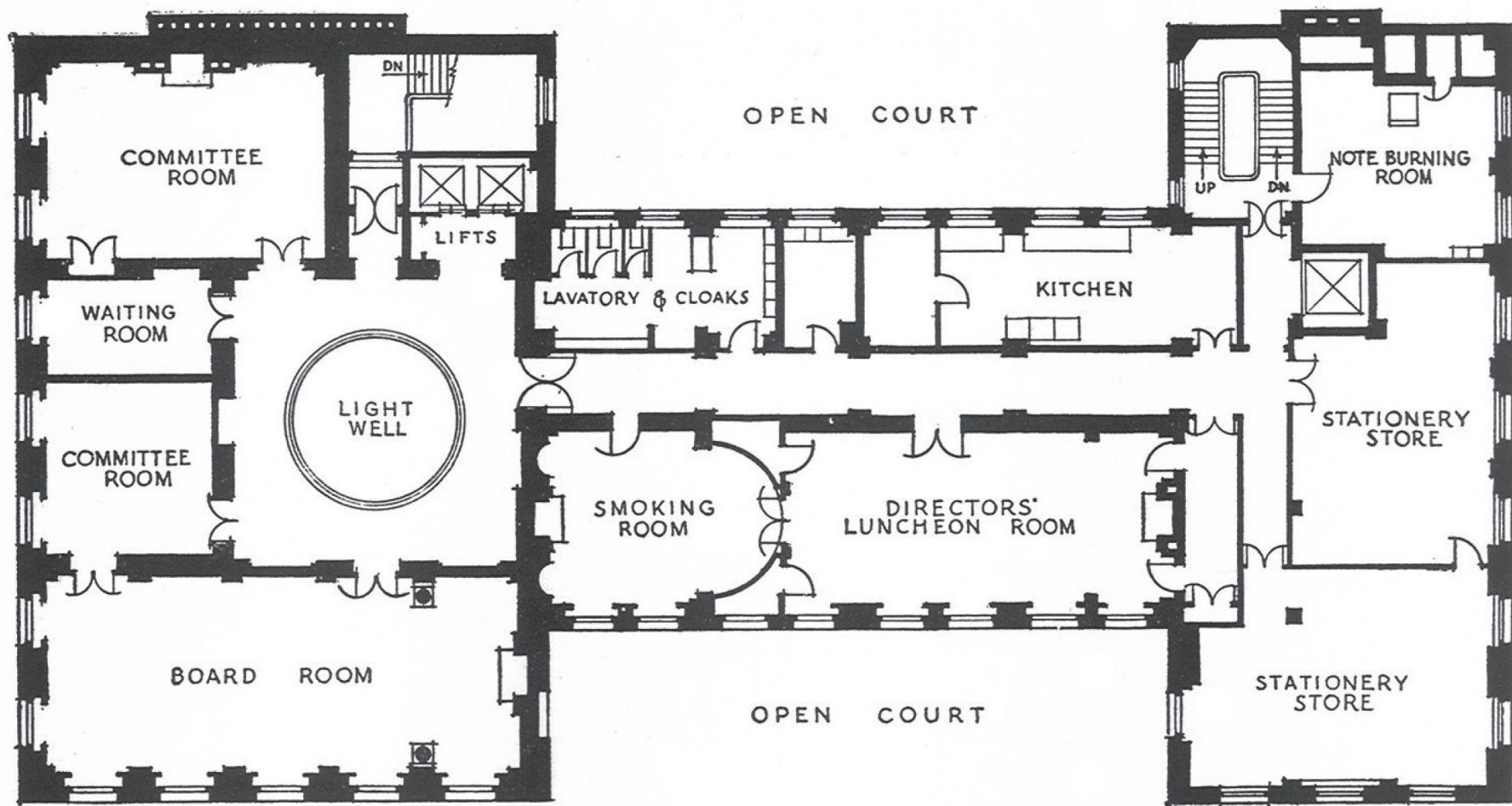
Central Coast, California, USA

Deep purple colour with aromas of blackberry, black raspberries and hints of cola and leather. Flavours are savory with a spicy smoky character, refreshing juicy acidity and a touch of French oak. Balanced alcohol gives the wine a suppleness that make it an easy drinker.

Rully, Clos de Bellecroix, Domaine Chanzy - - £65

Rully, Cote Chalonnaise, Burgundy, France

Blackcurrant, cherry and blackberry give way to floral notes of violet and rose.

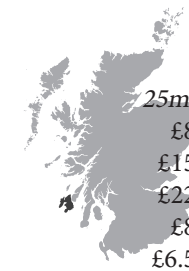
